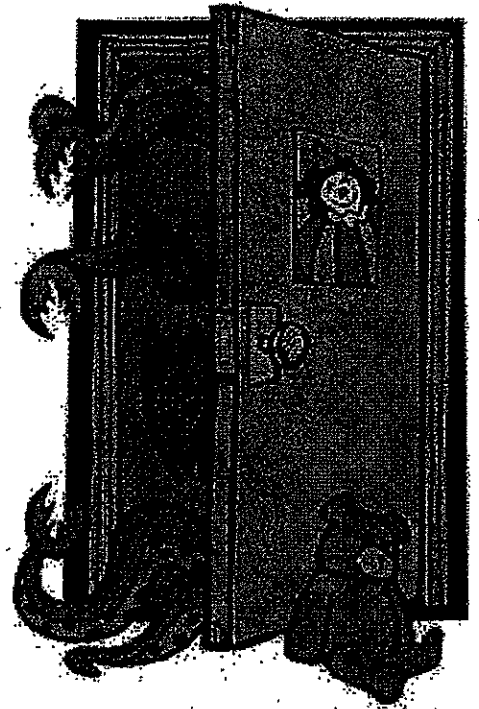
"Adam?" David asked in a groggy voice. "What are you doing in here?"

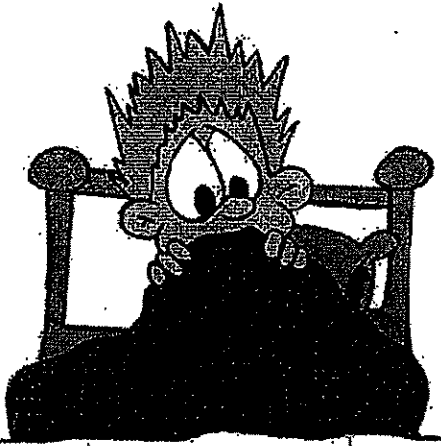
Adam tugged on David's arm. "There's something in my closet!"
